**TITLE: PROPOSED NEW VCCS POLICY MANUAL SECTION 6.0.0.1—
APPLICATION FOR READMISSION TO THE COLLEGE (SB) -
(Academic, Student Affairs, and Workforce Development Committee, Action
Item III.A.2.b.)**

BACKGROUND:

At its March meeting, ASAC approved a new section to be added to the Policy Manual which addresses a student's readmission to the college. At its April meeting, ACOP approved this proposed new policy. A student in "good academic standing" is defined as follows:

5.6.6 Academic Standing (SB)

Students are considered to be "in good academic standing" if they maintain a semester minimum GPA of 2.00, are eligible to reenroll at the college, and are not on academic suspension or dismissal status. Students on academic warning or academic probation who are eligible to reenroll may be considered eligible to receive financial aid assistance or other benefits requiring a "good academic standing" status.

ACTION RECOMMENDED:

It is recommended that the State Board for Community Colleges approve the proposed new policy regarding readmission of students to the college:

6.0.0.1 Application for Readmission to the College (SB)

If a student in "good academic standing" (as defined in Section 5.6.6) has not been enrolled within the last three years (nine terms), he/she will be required to complete a new application for admission.
