

Workreadiness Resolution (WRS)

January 7, 2011

Whereas, Virginia's Workplace Readiness Skills were developed through extensive research conducted in 1997 by employers and the University of Virginia's Weldon Cooper Center; and

Whereas, the resulting 13 Workplace Readiness Skills created for K-12 curricula have been updated to 21 Workplace Readiness Skills for full integration into the Career and Technical Education (CTE) Curriculum at K-12 institutions; and

Whereas, work readiness is of paramount priority in order for Virginia and its citizens to compete globally; now therefore, be it

Resolved by the Virginia Workforce Council, that all agencies of the Commonwealth should encourage the immediate approval and timely implementation of the revised Virginia Workplace Readiness Skills and National Occupational Competency Testing Institute (NOCTI) test.
