

Fall 2020 Pathways Program requirements

All Pathways Program students who are eligible to work can receive a stipend of \$500 in fall semester. (Students not eligible to work may still qualify to receive the stipend, but need to confirm with advisors.) Below are the requirements for both students in the Pathways Program who intend to receive a stipend (orange box) and requirements for students who do not intend to receive a stipend (grey box).

The requirements are equivalent from semester to semester; however, because of the online status of our program in Fall 2020, some specific requirements may differ from past or future semesters.

For students intending to receive a stipend

To maintain status in the program and **receive the stipend**, Pathways Program students must do the following in fall semester*

- Enroll in at least 6 credits
- Maintain or make progress towards a 2.5 GPA
- Meet two times with Transfer Coach and/or Transfer Coordinator
- Attend Application Day (if eligible and not attended in Fall 2019)



Attend at least one event per week (9/14/20 – 12/4/20, no events week of 11/23), from the following:

- Virtual event/discussion
- Folio Café
- e-Portfolio Reflection Consultation (by appointment, October 9 - 29)
- *Putting the Humanities to Work* panel
- e-Portfolio showcase in last week of session
- Book group

Important notes:

- Some e-Portfolio prompts are connected to virtual events, so you should plan to attend at least one virtual event in the first month.
- Not all types of events will be held every week. The schedule for the upcoming week is in the Friday newsletter and on the webpage.
- We understand that there are sometimes circumstances beyond your control. If you foresee a week when you will not be able to attend an event, please let us know in advance so that we can schedule an alternate time for you.



e-Portfolio assignment

- Complete e-Portfolio assignment
 - By October 9th, at least 2 e-Portfolio entries
 - By October 30th, revisions on first 2 e-Portfolio entries
 - By November 13th, all 4 e-Portfolio entries
 - By December 4th, revisions on all 4 e-Portfolio entries

For students not intending to receive a stipend

To maintain status in the program, Pathways Program students **not receiving a stipend** must do the following*

- Enroll in at least 6 credits
- Maintain or make progress towards a 2.5 GPA
- Meet two times with Transfer Coach and/or Transfer Coordinator
- Attend Application Day (if eligible and not attended in Fall 2019)
- Attend three events (from the following: virtual event/discussion, *Putting the Humanities to Work* panel, e-Portfolio showcase, book group)
