Frequently **Asked Questions**

WHAT COURSES CAN I TAKE?

A wide variety of courses are available. Talk to your high school counselor to find options that align with your interests and goals.

AM I ELIGIBLE?

Eligibility is determined by meeting academic readiness criteria. Check with your counselor or local college for details.

WILL MY CREDITS TRANSFER?

Yes, most credits transfer to Virginia colleges and universities. Acceptance depends on your chosen major and institution.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

Many classes are free or offered at reduced rates. Some costs, like textbooks, may vary based on the course and school.

IS FINANCIAL AID AVAILABLE FOR DUAL ENROLLMENT?

Federal and state financial aid is not available for dual enrollment students. However, some Virginia community colleges and school districts offer tuition assistance for eligible students.

CAN I EARN HIGH SCHOOL CREDITS?

Yes, in most cases, you can earn both high school and college credits when you take dual enrollment courses at your high school.

ARE ONLINE COURSES AVAILABLE?

Yes, some colleges offer online dual enrollment courses. Availability varies, so confirm specifics with your college.
